BOOK YOUR SLIP! SNYC Cruise to Annapolis, MD for Memorial Day Weekend, Friday to Monday, May 27 – 30, 2016. We will be staying at The Yacht Basin Marina, 2 Compromise Street, Annapolis, MD 21401. Their website is www.yachtbasin.com and their contact numbers are 410-263-3544 (telephone) and 410-269-1319 (fax).

Established in 1937, The Yacht Basin Company is the oldest privately owned marina in Annapolis. It has fixed docks, and their three deep water face docks routinely welcome boats up to 240'!

This marina is next to the Annapolis Marriot, and is walking distance to all of your favorite spots in downtown Annapolis as well as Eastport. There is no pool at the marina, but with so much so close in Historic Annapolis you won't even miss it! The marina is near the mooring balls of the City of Annapolis.

The transient rate is \$2.75/foot/day under 60' LOA and \$3.00/foot/day over 61' LOA. The Daily electric charges are 30 Amp-\$10.00 Each and 50 Amp-\$18.00 Each. You are welcome to stay as few or as many nights as fit your schedule.

BOOK YOUR SLIP AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IF YOU ARE THINKING ABOUT TAKING THE CRUISE! Memorial Day weekend is also the end of Commissioning Week (Commencement) for the United States Naval Academy, so the marina will fill up. There is a 48 hour cancellation policy. You can check in at 12 Noon, and check out is 11 AM.
