## June Cruise Friday, June 12, 2015 to Sunday, June 14, 2015

The June SNYC Cruise is to *Mear's Great Oak Landing Marina*, Chestertown, MD. The discounted rate, if we have 5 boats or more, is \$2.06 which is 25% off the weekend rate of \$2.75. There is a ONE NIGHT MINIMUM with a 48 HOUR CANCELLATION POLICY.

Electric rates are \$6/Day for 30 AMP Single, \$12/Day for 30 AMP Double, \$12/Day for 50 AMP Single and \$20/Day for 50 AMP Double.

This marina is a 70 acre "boater's paradise" overlooking Fairlee Creek. It is a great opportunity to hang out on the beach or at the pool. There is music during the day at *Jellyfish Joel's*, the tropical beach bar, and at *Mangrove's* on Friday and Saturday nights. You can also golf at the 9 Hole Golf Course!

SNYC planned activities include a Bar-B-Q on the beach for Saturday night dinner, and a potluck breakfast on Sunday morning.

## A Requested Recipe Great to make ahead

### BLT DIP

1 Lb Bacon-Chopped, cooked and drained  
1 Cup Mayonnaise  
1 Cup Sour Cream  
3 Green Onions sliced thin  
2 Tomatoes-Diced
